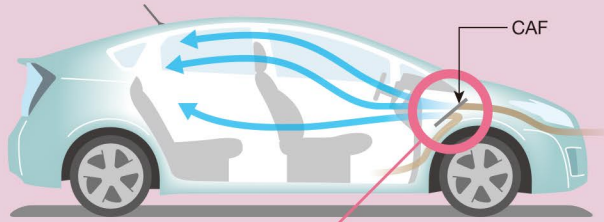
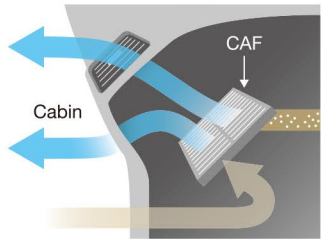


Cabin Air Filter (CAF)

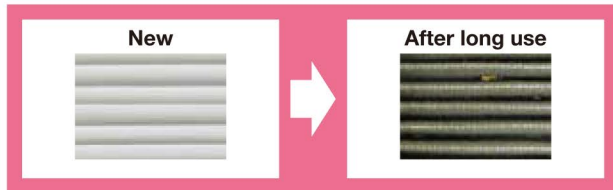


Just like with a household air-conditioner, a car's air-conditioner also has an air filter attached to it. It's called a Cabin Air Filter (CAF).



A CAF removes dust, pollen, and other unwanted particles from the outside air before it passes into the cabin, and also cleans air that is recirculated inside your vehicle.

(Note: Some models not fitted with CAFs)



In order to maintain a clean cabin environment, it is necessary to replace the CAF periodically.

If you continue to use an old CAF...

... it will eventually become clogged with dust and pollen, affecting the efficiency of your air-conditioner.

If you think there may be a problem with your CAF, we recommend you bring your car into a Toyota dealer for an inspection.

If you use an old or non-genuine CAF, you could find yourself in this situation...



I bought a non-genuine filter to save money, but it's not providing the same level of comfort the previous one did...

Can you tell which parts are genuine?

⚠ Beware of non-genuine parts!

They may look the same, but they don't offer the same performance.

Don't clean the CAF, periodically replace it.

Damage caused by cleaning

Even with thorough air blowing, it is impossible to remove all dirt from the CAF. Moreover, attempting to clean the CAF may cause damage that reduces its effectiveness.
