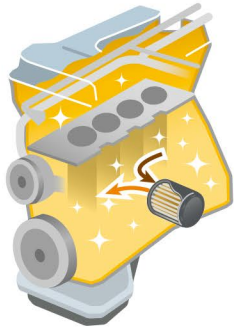
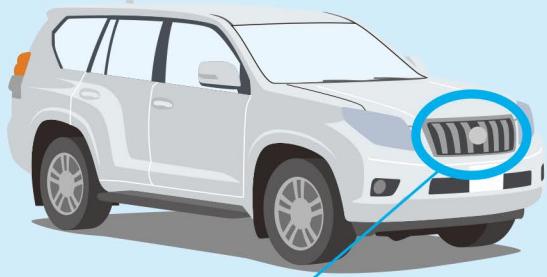
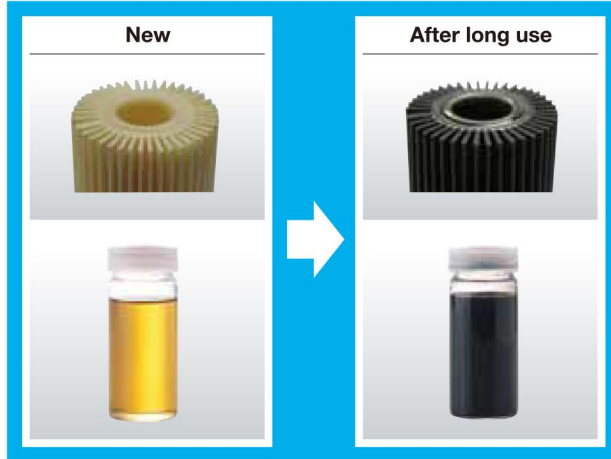


Oil filter



The role of the oil filter is to remove impurities such as carbon residue and metallic particles from the engine oil. If you continue to use an oil filter past the recommended replacement timing, the engine oil will become more viscous and the filter will become clogged. This will eventually cause engine problems.



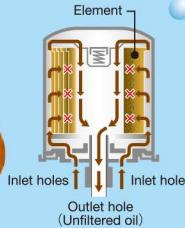
In order to keep your car's engine running smoothly, you need to ensure the engine oil remains clean. Therefore, it is important that the oil filter is periodically replaced.



If you think your oil filter may need to be checked, we recommend you bring your car into a Toyota dealer for an inspection.

If you don't replace the oil filter, these problems may occur...

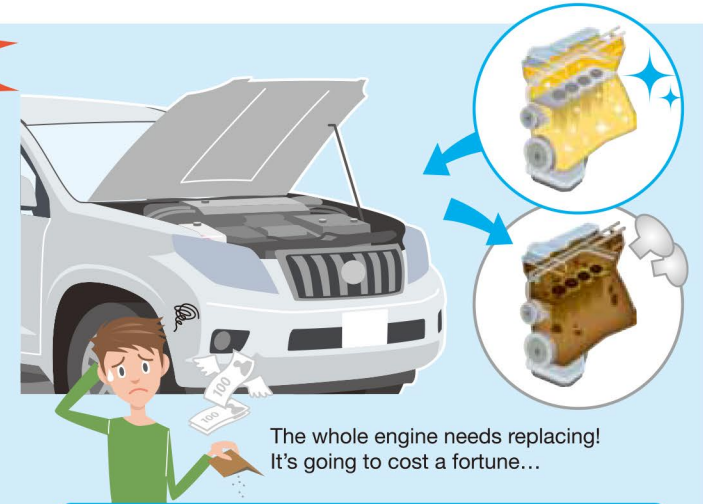
The filter has become clogged and the oil is not being filtered properly...

The engine has seized up!
